1. Invitation to Bid

The Government of Pakistan, under the Digital Nation Pakistan Act, 2025, has established the Pakistan Digital Authority (PDA) to lead and implement the country's digital transformation agenda. To execute this ambitious mandate, the Authority employs a highly specialized workforce comprising experts in Data Science, Digital Systems, Solution Architecture, Cyber Security, and AI. To support its operational requirements, PDA invites online bids via EPADS from reputable, and tax-registered firms for the **Supply of Eight (8) Quantity of NVIDIA DGX Spark AI Supercomputers** with Grace Blackwell Architecture featuring NVIDIA GB10 Grace Blackwell superchip, 1 PFLOPS of FP4 AI performance, 128GB of coherent, unified system memory, ConnectX-7 Smart NIC, 4TB NVME.M2 with self-encryption, and of size 150mm L x 150mm W x 50.5mm H.

2. Definitions

- a. **“Authority/PDA”** means Pakistan Digital Authority, a public sector authority established under applicable laws of Pakistan, responsible for digital governance, regulation, and oversight. PDA has its principal office at: 7th Floor, Kohsar Block, Pak Secretariat, Islamabad, Pakistan.
- b. **“Authorized Seller”** The bidder must be an authorized distributor, reseller, or partner of the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), or provide a valid OEM authorization letter specific to this procurement.
- c. **“Bidder” or “Offeror”** means any Company/Firm/Supplier that has responded to this Tender Notice by submitting a formal proposal/bid.
- d. **“Bidding Documents”** means the comprehensive set of documents issued by the Pakistan Digital Authority, acting as the Procuring Agency, to provide prospective Bidders with all necessary information required for the preparation and submission of their bids. These documents include, but are not limited to, definitions to minimize ambiguity, proposal solicitation requirements, instructions for Bidders, specifications, evaluation criteria, prescribed forms, and a draft agreement.
- e. **“Date of Issue”** means the date on which this Tender Notice is issued by the PDA to solicit bids from potential Bidders/Suppliers/Companies.
- f. **“Day”** means calendar day.
- g. **“PDA”** means Pakistan Digital Authority
- h. **“PPRA”** means the Public Procurement Rules, 2004, as amended from time to time.
- i. **“Tender Document”** means a set of documents prepared by the PDA to solicit proposals, which consists of definitions, instructions for bidders, specification, evaluation criteria, forms for providing information, etc.
- j. **“Scope of Work”** means the description of formal work activities under this Tender to be completed by the Successful Bidder in accordance with the Contract signed between the Successful Bidder and the PDA.
- k. **“Successful Bidder”** means a bidder who has been awarded the contract pursuant to this Tender and who shall be responsible for the supply of equipment as listed in the Scope of Work.



3. Introduction

The Pakistan Digital Authority (PDA) is a statutory body established under the **Digital Nation Pakistan Act 2025**, mandated to spearhead the country's transition into a digitally empowered nation. As the apex regulatory and implementation body, the Authority is tasked with executing the National Digital Masterplan to foster a robust Digital Economy, Digital Society, and Digital Governance. The PDA plays a pivotal role in driving policy formulation, digital infrastructure development, and the implementation of government-mandated programs to ensure Pakistan competes effectively in the global digital landscape. More details about the PDA are available at www.pda.gov.pk.

In alignment with national priorities for digital transformation and technological advancement, and in furtherance of the Digital Nation Act, the Procuring Agency intends to establish an advanced AI computing facility. This facility will support cutting-edge research, development of AI applications, training of large language models, computer vision applications, and other computationally intensive AI workloads.

The acquisition of NVIDIA DGX Spark A Grace Blackwell AI Supercomputers represents a significant investment in building indigenous AI capabilities and fostering innovation in Pakistan's technology sector. These systems will enable researchers, scientists, and developers to work on complex AI problems that require substantial computational power while maintaining a compact and energy-efficient infrastructure.

This procurement is being conducted in accordance with the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) Rules 2004 and all applicable laws and regulations governing public procurement in Pakistan.

4. Background

The Pakistan Digital Authority (PDA) is mandated to lead the nation's transformation. This is not a simple digitization effort; it is a fundamental re-architecting of our nation's economic future. We operate from the foundational truth that digital is the new operating system for our economy.

The Pakistan Digital Authority invites online quotations from eligible and authorized suppliers/vendors for the supply, delivery, installation, testing, commissioning, and warranty support of **Eight (08) units of NVIDIA DGX Spark A Grace Blackwell AI Supercomputers** with the specifications detailed in this document.

This procurement is being conducted through Tender Notice as per PPRA Rules 2004, which is appropriate for procurement of standardized, off-the-shelf goods of known specification.

The final evaluation shall be determined using a Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) methodology. The combined score will be calculated based on a weighted average, where the Technical Evaluation carries 70% and the Financial Evaluation carries 30% weightage.



Only bidders who are found technically qualified and meet the minimum technical qualifying score shall have their financial proposals opened and evaluated.

5. Scope of Work

The Bidder shall be responsible for complete supply, delivery, installation, testing, commissioning, and warranty support of **Eight (08) units of NVIDIA DGX Spark A Grace Blackwell AI Supercomputers** at the location(s) specified by the Procuring Agency.

11. Bid Evaluation

From the time of bid opening until the announcement of the Evaluation Report, no bidder shall contact the Pakistan Digital Authority (PDA) regarding any matter related to its Technical or Financial Proposal. Any attempt by a bidder to influence the examination, evaluation, ranking of proposals, or recommendation for award shall result in immediate rejection of the bidder's proposal.

PDA may, at its discretion, seek written clarifications from bidders on any aspect of the Technical Proposal or request missing historical or supporting documents, provided that such clarifications do not result in any material change to the substance of the bid or the Financial Proposal.

The bids shall be evaluated using the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) methodology, in accordance with applicable PPRA Rules. The final score shall be calculated on the basis of a weighted combination of Technical and Financial scores as follows:

The contract shall be awarded to the bidder achieving the highest combined technical and financial score.

Bidders are responsible for ensuring that all required documents and information are submitted with their proposals to enable evaluation strictly on the basis of the submitted documentation. PDA may conduct interviews or seek additional clarifications for evaluation purposes; however, no change to the submitted Financial Proposals shall be permitted at any stage.

12. Instructions for Bidders

9.1 Examination, Responsiveness, and Evaluation of Bids

Bids shall be examined and evaluated by the Bid Evaluation Committee(s) constituted by the Pakistan Digital Authority (PDA) in accordance with the evaluation methodology, criteria, and procedures specified in this Tender Document and in compliance with the **Public Procurement Rules, 2004**.

PDA shall examine bids to determine whether they are complete, properly signed, supported by required documents, arithmetically correct, and substantially responsive to the Tender requirements. A bid shall be considered **non-responsive** if it fails to conform to the Mandatory Requirements, Scope of Work, Technical or Financial Evaluation Criteria, or any other material requirement of this Tender.

Arithmetical errors shall be corrected as follows:



- Where there is a discrepancy between unit price and total price, the **unit price shall prevail**;
- Where there is a discrepancy between amounts in words and figures, the **amount in words shall prevail**.

Only substantially responsive bids shall be considered for further evaluation. No amendments or modifications to bids shall be permitted during evaluation.

9.2 Bidder's Responsibility

Bidders are responsible for carefully examining all instructions, forms, terms and conditions, specifications, and the Scope of Work contained in this Tender Document. Failure to provide complete information or submission of a non-responsive bid shall be at the bidder's own risk and may result in rejection.

Each bidder shall submit **only one bid**, in **English**, and shall nominate an authorized representative for official communication throughout the procurement process.

9.3 Right to Accept or Reject Proposals

PDA reserves the right, in accordance with PPRA Rules, to accept or reject any or all bids, annul the procurement process, or cancel this Tender at any time prior to award of contract, without assigning any reason and without incurring any liability.

13. Preparation of Proposal

10.1 Cost of Preparing Proposal

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid. PDA shall not be liable for any costs incurred, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the procurement process.

10.2 Proposal Currency and Pricing

All prices shall be quoted and payable in **Pakistani Rupees (PKR)**.

Quoted prices shall be **inclusive of all applicable Federal and Provincial taxes, duties, and levies**. Bidders shall provide a detailed tax breakdown in the Financial Proposal. The Financial Proposal shall be evaluated on the basis of the **total quoted price inclusive of all taxes**.

Prices quoted by the bidder shall remain **fixed for the duration of the contract** and shall not be subject to variation.

14. General Terms and Conditions

11.1 Procurement Procedure & Compliance

This procurement shall be conducted in accordance with the **Public Procurement Rules, 2004**, following the **Single Stage, Two Envelope procedure under Rule 36(b)**. All submissions, clarifications, amendments, and notifications shall be processed through **EPADS**, and the EPADS-published schedule shall prevail in case of any discrepancy.

11.2 Clarifications & Amendments

Bidders may request clarifications through EPADS up to the date specified in the procurement schedule. PDA may amend the Tender document by issuing a formal addendum through EPADS, which shall form an integral part of the Tender.

11.3 Confidentiality

Confidentiality shall be maintained for all information related to bid evaluation until announcement of the evaluation report, in accordance with **PPRA Rule 41**. Strict confidentiality of PDA employee data shall be maintained at all times. Any breach may result in disqualification or termination.

11.4 Conflict of Interest

A bidder shall be considered to have a conflict of interest and its bid shall be rejected if the bidder, its personnel, or affiliates:

- Have conflicting assignments compromising objectivity;
- Have business or family relationships with PDA officials involved in preparation, evaluation, selection, or supervision, unless resolved to PDA's satisfaction;
- Fail to disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest in writing.

Current PDA employees shall not work for the bidder. Non-disclosure may result in disqualification or termination.

11.5 Award of Contract and Contract Execution

PDA shall award the contract to the bidder whose proposal is determined to be the **most advantageous**, in accordance with the evaluation criteria. PDA is not bound to accept the lowest bid.

Upon issuance of the **Letter of Acceptance**, the successful bidder shall execute the contract within **fourteen (14) days** or within such extended period as mutually agreed. Failure to execute the contract may result in cancellation of the award.

11.6 Performance, Inspection & Acceptance

The bidder shall perform the contract in accordance with the Scope of Work and contractual obligations. PDA reserves the right to inspect goods at the manufacturer's premises, upon arrival, and during acceptance testing. Goods not conforming to specifications may be rejected.

11.7 Payments, Taxes & Insurance

Payments shall be made against **approved deliverables**, subject to inspection, satisfactory performance, and formal acceptance by PDA, in accordance with the Contract. All applicable taxes shall be governed by the laws of Pakistan. The bidder shall maintain adequate insurance coverage during transportation, delivery, installation, commissioning, and warranty period, as applicable.

11.8 Fraud, Corruption & Integrity

Bidders shall adhere to the highest ethical standards. Any involvement in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices shall result in rejection, termination, blacklisting, recovery of damages, and legal action. PDA may inspect and audit bidder records related to procurement and contract execution.

11.9 Force Majeure, Dispute Resolution & Governing Law

Neither party shall be liable for failure or delay due to Force Majeure events beyond reasonable control, subject to timely notification. Any dispute shall first be resolved amicably; failing which, it shall be referred to **arbitration under the Arbitration Act, 1940**, seated in Islamabad. This Tender and the resulting contract shall be governed by the laws of the **Islamic Republic of Pakistan**.
